# TEAS

## Russian Caravan

5

A fine blend of china, oolong and india teas with a distinct smokiness. The blend gets its' name from the 18th century camel caravans who transported teas from China, India and Ceylon through Russia. It is said that originally the light smokiness of this tea came from the campfires along the caravan route but nowadays it comes from the blending of smoky lapsang with the other leaves.

## Russian Samovar

5

Ever-present in the home interiors of Tolstoy and Dostoevsky novels, the samovar is metal urn used to heat water, traditionally used in Russia. This is a select blend of China & Oolong with more aromatic tones than other Russian teas.

## Darjeeling 1st Flush Soom Organic

10

The first flush is the picking of the brand new two leaves and a bud in the earliest spring growth of the plant, as early as February and often lasting through April. These early leaves are usually more delicate and tender and therefore more light, floral, fresh, brisk, and astringent in flavour.

A highly aromatic first flush with an excellent light green leaf of pure China origin. Sweet and soft in flavour, a tea whose quality you can profoundly enjoy. Founded in the 1860s, the name "Soom" derives from the local Lepcha language and means triangular due to the shape of the garden, bordered by the little Rangeet river in the higher Himalayas.

## Yunnan Imperial

7

In China's Yunnan Province, tea still grows as wild as the day it earned its host the accolade of the 'home of tea'. Even when tamed, the bushes produce sturdy buds, thick, well-sized leaves and attractive golden tips. The liquor is strong, malty and pleasantly distinctive. High-grade tea with lots of golden tip. A sweet-spicy flavour though soft aftertaste.

## Pu-Erh Mini Tuo-Cha

7

This mini tuo-cha pu-erh from China's Yunnan Province is hand formed, twice fermented, large leaf tea in a mini "bird's nest" shape - is perfect for travelling; it only requires a very short brew time and each piece can be used several times. Tuo-cha means 'tea head'

A dark, full-bodied tea yet with an distinctive but mild earthy taste. Pu-erh is said to have various positive health benefits such as an excellent aid to digestion. It is also said to help reduce cholesterol and aid weight loss.

## Chardwar Assam 2nd Flush, Organic

A classic assam 2nd flush from the Chardwar estate with deep malty flavour and bright amber cup.

The Chardwar estate is located in Sonitpur District on the banks of Brahmaputra river in India's Assam region. The hot humid day-time temperature, combined with heavy rainfall creates the ideal conditions for growing this fine organic tea.

## Yellow Tea

A chinese tea prized by buddhist monks, distinctive yellow tea. Mild, slightly spicy tones.

## Pingshui Pinhead Gunpowder

A premium gunpowder green tea from China where tea leaves are rolled tightly to resemble pellets similar to gunpowder. When brewed it produces a tea with a mild yet slightly smoky flavour.

Higher in caffeine than most chinese green teas, this gunpowder tea is used in China by athletes to aid endurance in training.

## White Monkey

White Monkey is a classic delicate tippy green tea. It is also referred to as a white tea due to its downy white appearance and pale amber liquor.

According to legend, this tea was picked by specially trained monkeys. It is also named for the shape of the leaves which are hand-rolled to resemble a white monkey's paw. From the Wuyi mountains in China's Fujian province.



<b>Dragon Well Organic</b>	18
<p>A top quality tea which received its' name from ancient Chinese legend. The grandson of emperor Kangxi of the Qing Dynasty had found it at a temple called Hu Gong. The emperor was so impressed he granted the original 18 Lung Ching tea bushes the title Gong Cha (imperial tea).</p> <p>Lung Jing is often called the national drink of china and is frequently given to visiting heads of state. It is also a favourite tea of today's top leaders, with a portion of production reserved for government. Rich in vitamin C. A pale yellow cup and a must for anyone interested in classic teas.</p> <p>Light and fruity but holding its essential high grown green qualities.</p>	
<b>Jasmine Green With Flowers</b>	5.5
<p>Jasmine with flowers is the classic scented tea from china. Fresh and mellow, with slight astringency, this a fine palate cleanser with food which is why western people know it so well from their visits to chinese restaurants.</p> <p>Jasmine blossoms placed over the green tea leaves which then absorb the scent of the flowers produce the distinct and well-loved flavour. In this grade of jasmine the flowers are left in with the tea leaves.</p>	
<b>Lin Yun White Downy</b>	7
<p>Plump and tender, needle-shaped buds are carefully selected to produce this very delicate white tea. The names derives from the appearance of the buds which are plucked when they are barely emerging and are covered in silvery "white down". It originates in the "Lin Yun" county of the Guang Xi province in southern China. White tea is light and fine and is very low in caffeine. This Lin Yun white downy brews to a bright and delicately yellow liquor. The flavour is very slightly nutty, yet sweet and mellow.</p>	
<b>Iron Goddess Of Mercy Tie Guan Yin</b>	9
<p>Our iron goddess tea celebrates the Chinese goddess of mercy, Guanyin (or Ti Kuan Yin). According to one legend, Guanyin appeared in a dream to a poor farmer who worshipped at her falling down temple. She told him of a cave behind the temple where treasure awaited to be shared. In the cave the farmer found a single tea sapling which he planted and nurtured it into a large bush. It produced an exceptionally fine tea and he shared cuttings with his neighbours. Their fortunes turned and they were able to repair the temple. From Fujian province, China, this is a 15% fermentation, with a very large leaf tightly rolled into dark, compact balls (often seen as iron like), is a very smooth drink with a naturally sweet, aromatic, nutty taste.</p>	
<b>China Lychee Lizhi Hongcha</b>	6
<p>Lizhi Hongcha is a favourite, traditionally scented, Chinese black tea. The lychee flavour is delicate and floral with fragrant honey tones.</p> <p>The lychee is a sweet and juicy tropical fruit, indigenous to southern China and abundant throughout Asia. The scent in the tea is achieved by mixing the tea leaves with lychee peels &amp; flowers during the oxidising process. The result is a beautifully aromatic tea – one which has been enjoyed since the Ming Dynasty (1368-1644). A true Chinese classic.</p>	
<b>Chai Spices</b>	7
<p>This balance of spices and herbs creates a fresh uplifting chai. Includes: aniseed, cardamom seeds, ginger pieces, black pepper, cinnamon pieces, fennel, cloves, chicory roots.</p>	
<b>Pure Rosebuds</b>	8
